

Data Protection Policy – January 2014

Hart Road Runners (HRR) takes the responsibility of looking after members personal data very seriously.

HRR collect personal information from club members ranging from Name and Address through to general information regarding running activities and performances, some of this information may be deemed public and non-sensitive. HRR use the information they collect solely for club purposes and use all reasonable efforts to protect such data. Information is only shared among Committee members when there is a need to do so. In the event that any data is lost or potentially lost, the Committee will, with all due haste, act to mitigate this loss or potential loss.

HRR will only use your information with your express permission and only for the purpose for which the permission was given.

HRR will never pass your information on to third parties. If any member feels that HRR have misused their information please make us aware of the full circumstances, providing as much information as possible, as soon as possible after the incident and email this information, under the strictest confidence to the Club Secretary.
